Application Process

Due to the high expectations and the rather low number of participants, the application process will precede due to a selection process based on submitted work samples. Both design and written works are welcomed for

Participants

The workshop addresses students and professionals in the fields of Architecture, Urban Planning, Project Management, Engineering, Sociology, Communications, and Systems Theory. Students should encompass a Bachelor degree or higher. Maximum 30 participates.

Workshop period

The workshop starts with an opening reception August 23. and ends with a closing reception September 10.

Costs

Workshop fee is 450 EUR

The workshop fee covers welcome reception in Johannesburg; studio place in Johannesburg during the workshop period, with access to printing and internet facilities; participation and academic guidance; closing reception; and applicable documents for credits and references.

Deadlines

May 31 2010

Applications should be submitted to RIEAch by midnight Central European Standard Time (CET).

Applicants will be notified by email.

Accepted participants must confirm their enrollment by paying the workshop fee.
